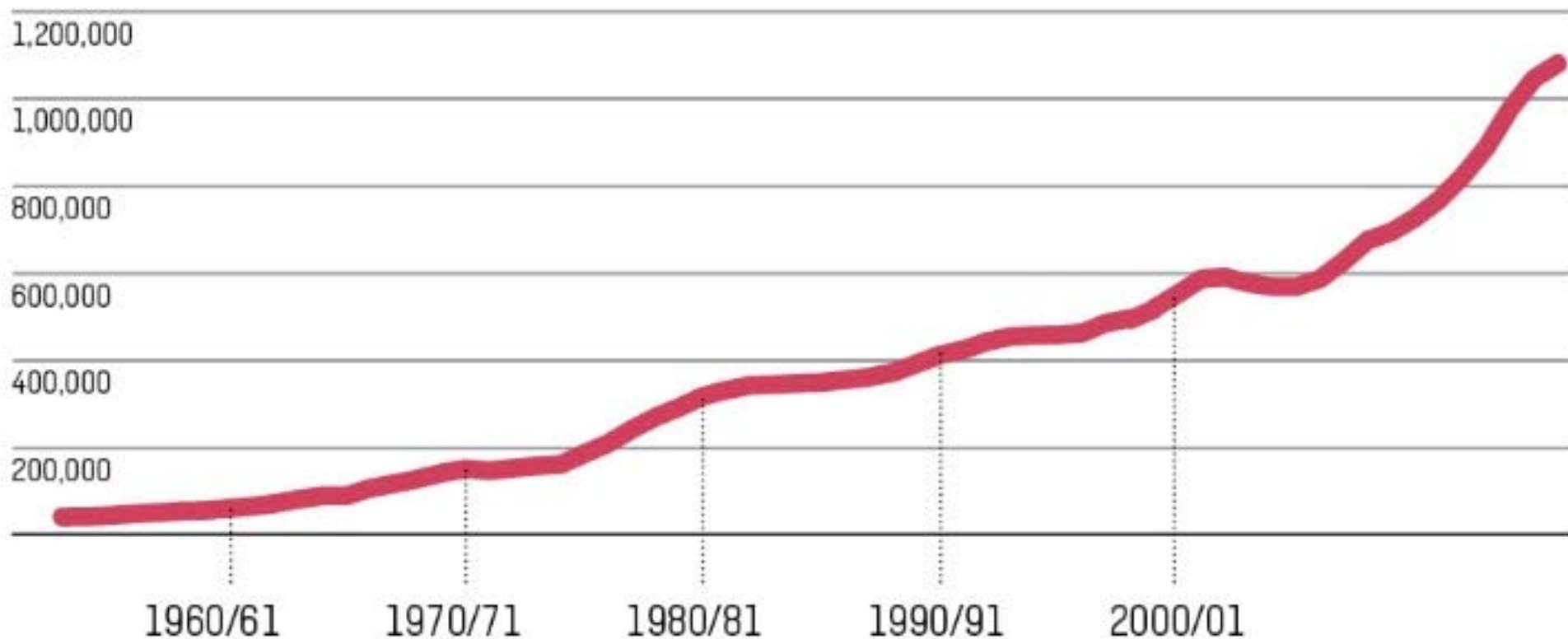

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS IN THE U.S. 1953/54 – 2016/17

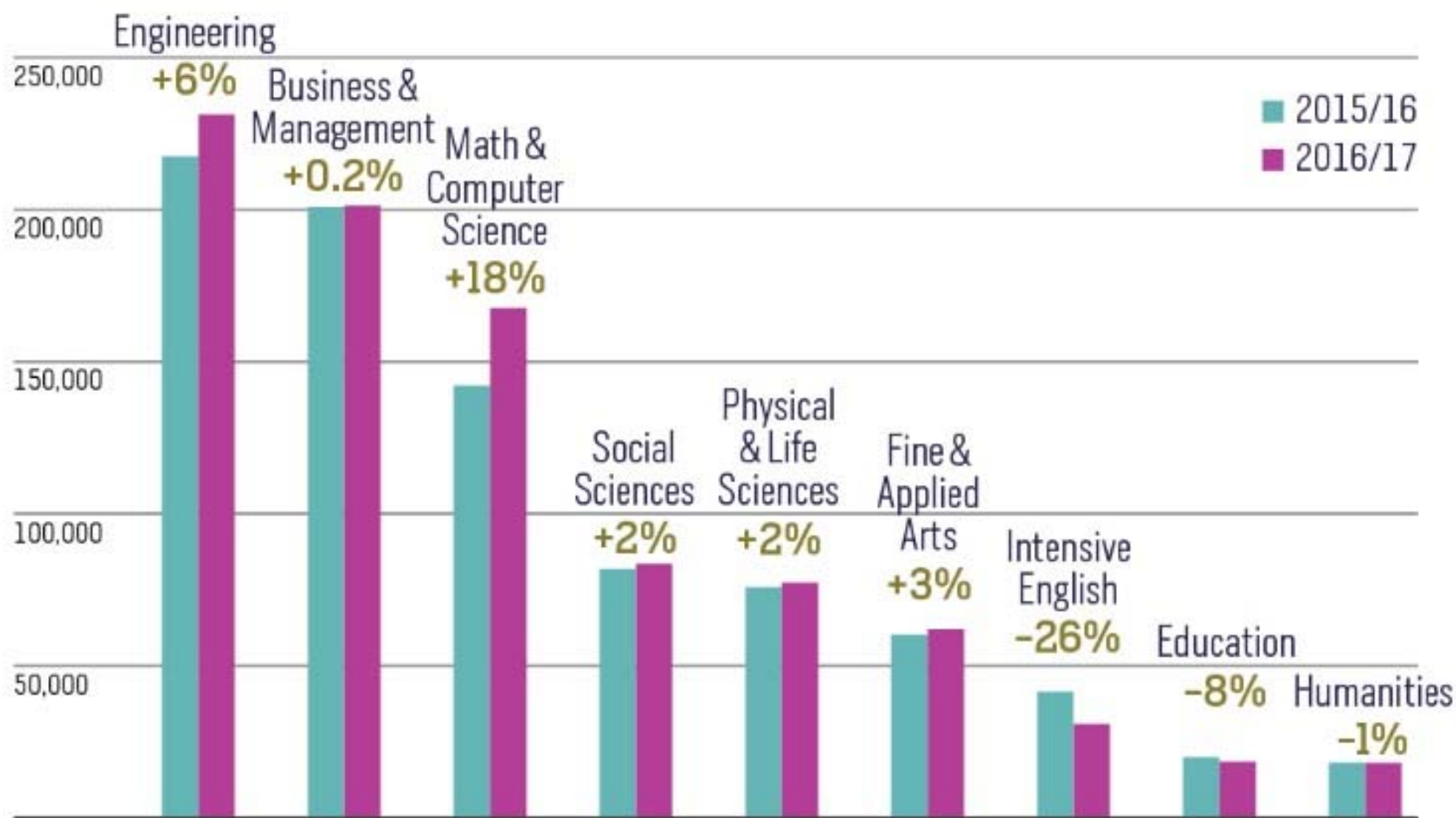


In 2016/17 there was **an increase of 3.4%** over the prior year in the number of international students in the United States.

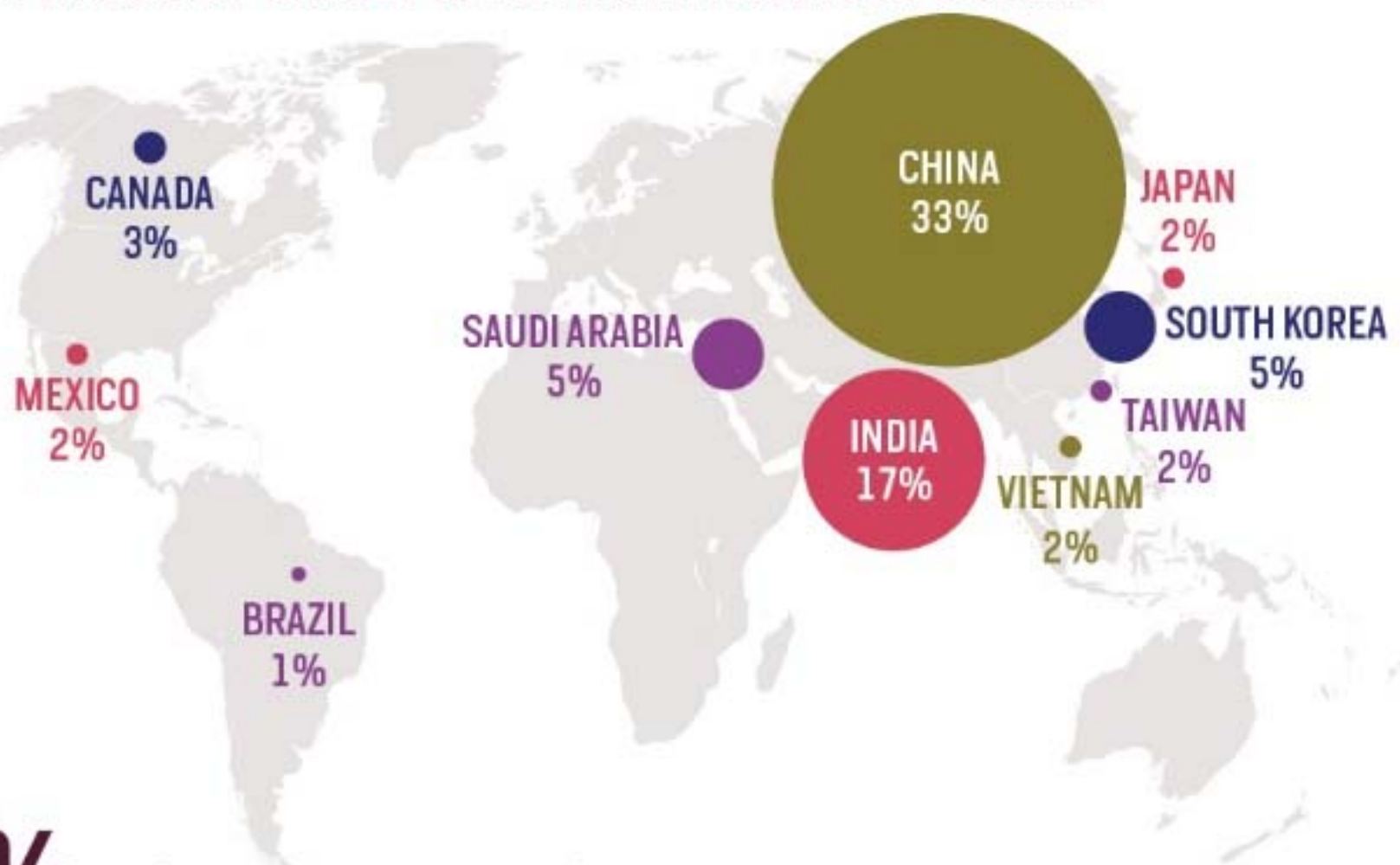
GROWTH IN SELECTED FIELDS OF STUDY OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

TOP TEN PLACES OF ORIGIN OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

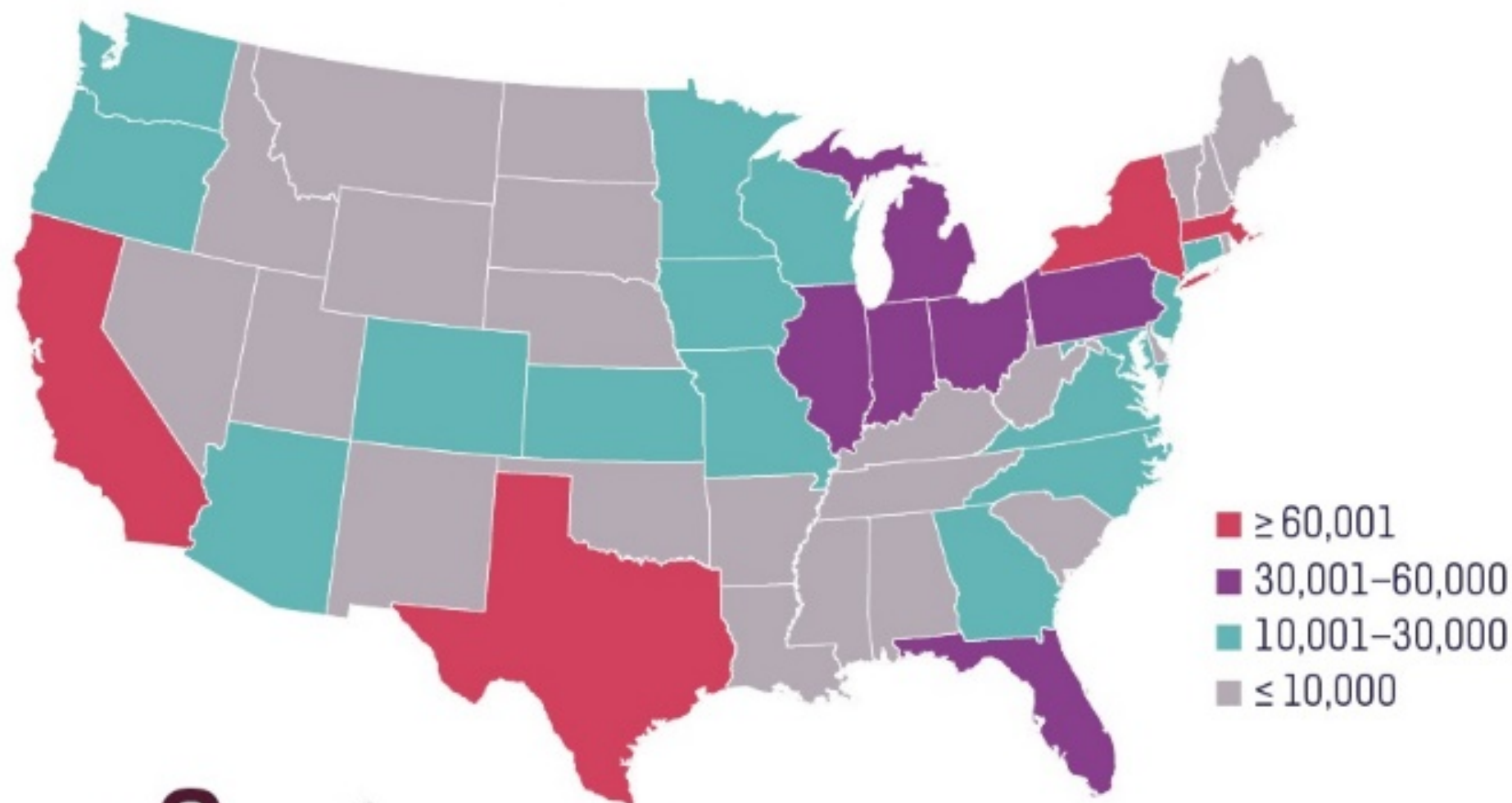


50% of international students
